

London Marathon 2027 Terms and Conditions

How we may contact you:

We will use your contact information to stay in touch with you about your application and notify you about the outcome. We may need to get in touch to ask for some more information before we can make a decision. If you are given our charity place, we will use your information to stay in touch about the event, provide fundraising information, and important 'need to know' info. This is separate to our marketing opt-in process and a condition of entry to this event.

All use of your personal data will be in accordance with our [Privacy Notice](#), including the sharing of your data with the Challenge Organiser.

Organisation of the race:

The TCS London Marathon will be held on 25 April 2027 (TBC). This Challenge is being organised and run by London Marathon Events (LME).

Challenge Terms and Conditions:

You must read and accept the Terms and Conditions issued by the Challenge Organiser (LME) and comply with these. You can find the terms on their [website here](#).

Charity Place

1. An application is not a guarantee of a place. Applications will be reviewed and the successful applicant will be notified.

All applicants will receive correspondence to let them know whether they have been successful in securing our charity place. This will be the week after the official ballot results have been announced by LME.

2. The successful applicant will be required to pay a nonrefundable registration fee of £100 to secure their National Star charity place within 2 weeks of being informed they have the place (details of how to pay this will be provided when the place is allocated.)

3. You are encouraged to also enter the official ballot and let us know as soon as possible if you are successful in receiving a ballot place. The results are normally released in July via email over the course of a week. If you are successful, it would be wonderful if you still choose to fundraise for National Star.

4. You must be at least 18 years of age on the date of your application.

5. You will be sent information to formally register with London Marathon on their Registration Console using the National Star charity place. You commit to completing this information in a timely manner and by any deadlines set by National Star/LME or risk forfeiting your place.
6. You must inform National Star, as soon as possible, of any reason you are unable to take part in the London Marathon 2027. This place cannot be deferred for any reason.
7. By agreeing to these terms and conditions, if you are successful in receiving a place, you are committing to raise a minimum of £2,000 (not including Gift Aid or Match-funding). To show your commitment, we recommend that you register with LME recommended online fundraising platform (Enthuse) as soon as we send you the information to do so. £1,000 must be raised by 27 January 2027.
8. National Star reserves the right to remove your name from the London Marathon Registration Console if you do not adhere to our Terms and Conditions, do not respond to communications, or do not start your fundraising in a timely manner. We will communicate with you before we revoke your place.
9. If the Challenge is cancelled (and you don't transfer to the rescheduled event), you decide not to participate, or your place is revoked due to not adhering to our Terms and Conditions, you are responsible for contacting your sponsors and donors to inform them that you are no longer taking part and for confirming with them whether they are happy for the money they have donated to still be given to National Star. If you are using sponsorship forms as part of your fundraising, all sponsorship forms and monies collected should be forwarded to us or returned to your sponsors in accordance with their wishes.
10. You are responsible for reading and agreeing to information provided by London Marathon Events, particularly their Terms and Conditions around collection of your running number, event safety and liability.
