







 residence at the start of  September.









 I will have a  Residential Manager and a  Keyworker  to  help me at





 I  will have time to  look  around  my  new  residence,  so that I know

 I  will have time to  settle in to  my  new  residence  before  College









 sessions  start.

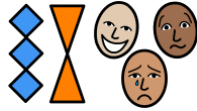




