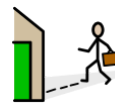

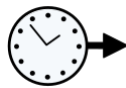

 residence at the start of  September.












 I  can talk to  my family  on the phone,  by video call,  and  using




