Choosing the type of gift in your Will

Your Will is your chance to look after the people you love, and we understand this completely. But if you would like to join National Star in our promise to young people with complex disabilities by leaving us a gift in your Will, there are different ways of doing this.

A share of your estate

Once you have taken care of your loved ones, you can leave a share or the remainder of your estate to us. This is called a **residuary gift**.

A gift of money in your Will

You can choose to support National Star with a specific amount of money in your Will. This is called a **pecuniary gift**. It's worth bearing in mind that inflation can reduce its value over time, so we recommend reviewing your Will from time to time to make sure it still reflects your intentions.

A specific gift in your Will

You can choose to leave us a specific item, such as jewellery, shares, or even a house when making a Will. This is called a **specific gift**.
